

STIPEND PROGRAM

Through the generous support of the Bradley Family, the Bremyer Fund and the Public Interest Law Student Fund, KU Law has stipends available to help students offset the expenses incurred when they take legal positions that will provide 240+ hours of work. Applications are due by March 30 and available in the Career Services Office.

Students who qualify

- Enrolled in good standing at KU Law.
- Have a qualifying summer offer as a 1L or 2L, or a qualifying offer for the 6th Semester in D.C. Program as a 3L.

Exclusions

- Judicial internships qualify unless they are arranged through the Judicial Field Placement Program.
- Positions arranged through Criminal Prosecution, Elder Law, and Medical Legal Partnership Field Placement Programs are excluded.
- Work for political parties or campaigns is excluded.

Funds available

Bradley Fund

For credit or not-for-credit; Unpaid or paid with remaining financial need; Work with government agency, non-profit, charitable organization or private firm if student is working solely on pro bono matters; Direct provision of legal services, or work that supports legal issues or legislative matters; Must be related to voting rights or environmental issues; Summer internship; 6th Semester in D.C. program.

Bremyer Fund

For credit or not-for-credit; Paid or unpaid; Public interest or private practice; Direct provision of legal services, or work that supports legal issues or legislative matters; Work location must be in a Kansas county excluding Douglas, Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee and Wyandotte; Summer internship.

PILS Fund

For credit or not-for-credit; Unpaid, or paid with remaining financial need; Work with government agency, non-profit, charitable organization or private firm only if student is working solely on pro bono matters; Direct provision of legal services, or work that supports legal issues or legislative matters; Summer internship.

Deadlines

Application due: March 30

Applications received by March 30 will be reviewed together, and notifications of awards will be sent on April 10. Requests received after March 30 will be reviewed on a rolling basis, if funds are still available. Stipend applications for 6th Semester in D.C. will be reviewed when received.
