**Time commitment:** The Project for Innocence requires, in addition to class, a minimum time commitment of twelve to fifteen (12-15) hours per week in the fall and spring, and twenty-five (25) hours per week in the summer. You will also be asked to attend a Boot Camp before the beginning of the semester. Please apply only if you are willing to devote your full energies to your clients' needs. You will be notified of acceptance and the date of Boot Camp prior to enrollment.

If you are accepted, you will be asked to sign statements of 1) intent to enroll in the Project, 2) conflict of interest and, 3) confidentiality.
